



AUDITIONING FOR HIGH SCHOOL MUSICAL

SPRING 2026

A Step By Step Guide

STEP 1: SIGN UP

- Fill out the registration form beforehand (10 - 15 min). Be sure to read it carefully.

- Sign up for an audition time via Sign Up Genius.

Be sure to complete both steps prior to auditions. Please note that they are two separate steps/links.

STEP 2: PREPARE

Get familiar with the material for the initial audition and callbacks.

- Research the show, the characters, and listen to the cast recording.

- VOCAL AUDITION
 - Please prepare an *a cappella* song (no music or starting notes) up to **16 bars** or approximately **30 seconds** in length.
 - We may ask you to vocalize during your audition to hear more of your range. Choose a song in **the style of the show**. Songs from the show or callback material are welcome! Use this as an opportunity to showcase a role you're drawn to. If your song runs long, we may ask you to stop for time - don't worry, this is normal!
- DANCE AUDITION
 - A short dance routine will be **taught in the audition room** - no pre-recorded dance videos will be used.
 - Please wear clothing and shoes that allow you to **move comfortably**.
- Callback material is also posted below. Feel free to get familiar!

STEP 3: AUDITION DAY

- Wear shoes and clothes that allow you to move and dance easily.
- Bring a water bottle labeled with your name.
- Print out and complete the two below documents. Your actor **MUST HAVE BOTH** completed and turned in in order to audition.

- Arrive at the Community House 10 minutes before your scheduled audition time and look for the signs for the check in room.
- Check in, have an audition day photo taken by the production team and be measured for costumes.
Please allow approximately 2 hours for the audition. The audition group will then be divided into two separate groups, half will sing first and half will dance first. The groups will then switch. Once you have done both, you are done!

AFTER AUDITIONS

- Callbacks will be made via email on Monday, January 12th after 4pm. You will be notified what roles you are called back for and what you should prepare for your callback day.
- If you do not receive a callback, you will also receive an email after 4pm. Please don't let that get you down! Take the opportunity to keep training and come audition again next time!
Keep in mind that receiving a callback does not guarantee that you will be cast.

STEP 4: CALLBACKS

- After you receive your callback on Monday, January 12th, get started on your preparation!
- Your callback email will give you an assigned time slot for Tuesday, January 13th between 4 - 8pm.
- Get familiar with the callback materials!

- Knowledge of the music and the show demonstrates to us who is prepared and makes a huge impression!
- As with auditions, arrive at the Community House 10 minutes before your scheduled callback time, wear shoes and clothes that allow you to move and dance easily, and bring a water bottle.
